

“International Commission on Irrigation and Drainage (ICID)”, is a professional and voluntary Not-for-Profit, Non-Government International Organization (NGO) with its headquarter located in New Delhi, India.

ICID is the only international organization involved exclusively in irrigation, drainage and flood management with the objective to achieve local, national and global level food security. The Commission provides a unique global platform for the exchange of knowledge, information and networking related to agricultural water management.

The membership of the Commission consists of National Committees (NCs). Presently, professionals engaged in irrigation and drainage sector participate in ICID through the National Committees of their countries. ICID network covers around eighty countries across the regions of Africa, Americas, Asia and Oceania, and Europe representing over 90% of the world irrigated area. ICID organizes triennial Congresses - addressing specific questions, World Irrigation Forum, Regional Conferences, International Drainage Workshops, International Micro Irrigation Symposium, etc. on a regular basis. The Commission brings together experts from different parts of the world to share their experiences and knowledge on specific issues through ICID Workbodies. The workbodies develop manuals, guidelines and special publications from time to time.

Besides country membership through National Committees (please refer to the membership network map on the back cover), ICID now invites private companies, institutions and individuals involved in agriculture water management to join as a 'Direct Member'.
